

## **The Attributes of God – Truthfulness**

### **I. God (Yahweh) is the One True God**

- He is the creator, maker and sustainer of the universe.
- Discuss who is NOT God...
- What does God's Word say:
  - ✓ Jeremiah 10:10 (Read 1-9 as you have time)
  - ✓ Isaiah 46:9
  - ✓ 1 Kings 8:60

### **II. God is Truthful**

- He is the living, eternal and all wise God, who knows all things as they are.
  - ✓ Isaiah 40:12-13
- God Reveals His Truthfulness Through...
  - ❖ His Word
    - ✓ 2 Samuel 7:28
    - ✓ Psalm 119:160
    - ✓ John 17:17
  - ❖ His Son
    - ✓ John 1:14
    - ✓ John 1:17
    - ✓ John 8:31-32
    - ✓ John 14:6
  - ❖ His Holy Spirit
    - ✓ John 16:13-14

### **III. God is Faithful** – Because He is the one true God and all of His words are truthful; therefore, He is entirely dependable and steadfast.

- ✓ Deuteronomy 7:9
- ✓ Hebrews 10:23

### **IV. Do we believe this?**

- Do you know God and His TRUTH, abiding in Him, reading, meditating, memorizing and LIVING His Word?
- Are you thriving or floundering?
  - ✓ 1 Peter 5:8
  - ✓ Ephesians 6:14-17

### **V. Let's look at some lies of Satan's and apply God's truth to it!**

- Lie 1: Jesus' friendship is not enough—
  - ❖ Where is our security?
  - ❖ Truths to focus on: Heb 12:2; Matt 28:20, John 15:4, Col 3:2
- Lie 2: I am worthless, insignificant, don't measure up. Need to just "believe in myself."
  - ❖ My identity is Christ – always point to Him
  - ❖ Truths to focus on: Gen 1:27; Col 3:12, Eph 2:8-9; Jesus' truth to disciples: Matt 16:17; Matt 19:27-29, John 17:6, Luke 9:54-55.
- Lie 3: If I FEEL it, it must be true. I simply can't help how I react when these feelings take over.
  - ❖ God's truth brings peace, not turmoil.
  - ❖ Truths to focus on: Eph 3:20; Isaiah 41:10; Eph 6:4; Phil 4:4-7
