1. Read Luke 6:1-2. Which standards did the Pharisees rely upon to determine
what was "lawful"? Consult Mark 7:1–13. In which areas of your life do you find

2. Read **Luke 6:3–4**. What was Jesus' source of authority as He answered the objections of the religious leaders of His day? Consult **Matthew 19:3–6**; **John 10:30–38**. How does Jesus' example in wielding Scripture motivate you to be a more diligent and skilled student of God's Word?

3. Read **Luke 6:5**. How should the reality of Jesus' deity shape one's perspective on all areas of life? Consult **John 1:3**; **Colossians 2:8–10**; **Romans 14:5–9**.

4. Read **Luke 6:6–11**. What was the genius of Jesus' question in verse nine? In what way was He rebuking the Pharisees by asking that question? Consult **Luke 13:10–17**; **Luke 14:1–6**.
