The Gospel of Luke: True Revival  
Passage: Luke 7:1–17

1. Read **Luke 7:1–3, 11–12**. In these passages, Jesus both rewarded the faith of a Gentile centurion and demonstrated compassion toward a Gentile woman. What do these interactions reveal about the heart of Christ? Consult **Mark 1:39–41; Hebrews 4:15; Matthew 11:28–30**. How do these interactions foreshadow the ultimate reach of Jesus' message? Consult **Acts 1:8; Romans 1:16; Galatians 3:27–28**.

2. Read **Luke 7:4–7**. The Jewish elders had one conception of what it means to be “worthy,” while the centurion had another. How is one ultimately deemed “worthy” by God? Consult **Romans 5:1–2; Galatians 2:16**. What will the natural response be of one who has been deemed “worthy” by God, through faith? Consult **Ephesians 4:1–3**. What are some ways you are doing so? In which areas of your walk do you need to grow?

3. Read **Luke 7:10, 15**. In both of these encounters, Jesus revived an individual. What do His death-defeating capabilities indicate about His person and His power? Consult **Revelation 1:18**. How does Jesus' ultimate defeat of death give you hope and encouragement for today? Consult **John 11:25–26; 1 Corinthians 15:55–57**.
