1. In **Acts 1:8**, Jesus said to His disciples: “you shall be My witnesses.” In which spheres of your life are you acting as a witness for Christ? What are some specific ways you find yourself testifying to what Jesus Christ has done for you? What are some ways you can grow in faithfulness in this area?

2. In **Acts 1:8**, Jesus connected witnessing to Him to the power of the Holy Spirit. Do you pray for opportunities to share your hope in Christ (**Colossians 4:2-3**)? Why or why not?

3. What are some biblical examples of the message of the gospel going to “the ends of the earth” (**Acts 1:8**)? Consult **Matthew 28:19-20**; **Colossians 3:11**; **Philippians 4:22**; **Revelation 7:9-10**. How do these examples support the idea that a local church can be robust in its priority of local church matters, while also being supportive of the advance of the gospel more broadly?
