Passage: Psalm 103

1. Read **Psalm 103:13–16** and meditate on the understanding compassion of God. How should God's intimate knowledge of our frailty encourage us to praise Him? How should it look to take comfort in this truth when we're feeling the effects of our frailty?

2. Read **Psalm 103:8–12** and consider specific ways in which God has been gracious to you. Discuss how God's graciousness should relate to our ongoing sinfulness. Read and discuss how **Romans 5:20–6:1** and **Ephesians 2:8–10** fit into your answer.

3. Recount the various reminders outlined in **Psalm 103** which should fuel our praise. Which of these elements are you most prone to forgetting? Find a verse or two from elsewhere in Scripture which teach that truth clearly and share them with your group.
