One Flesh: The Requirements of a God-Honoring Marriage Jesse Randolph
Passage: Selected Scriptures

1. Read **2 Corinthians 5:17; Ephesians 1:7; Colossians 3:3**. What do these passages reveal about the believer's position in Christ? How should these salvation realities translate to faithful living in one's marriage? Consult **Colossians 3:12–14**. Is your marriage made up of two forgiven sinners who are actively seeking to walk “in newness of life” (**Romans 6:4**)?
2. Read **Galatians 5:22–23**. Is your marriage Spirit-filled? Meaning, are you and your spouse consistently demonstrating the fruit of the Spirit? In which areas of your life do you still need to grow in walking not “according to the flesh but according to the Spirit” (**Romans 8:4**)?
3. Read **2 Timothy 3:16–17; Psalm 1:1–3**. Why is the regular intake of God's Word an essential component of a God-honoring marriage? What are some of the ways Scripture points us to eternal realities which transcend our earthly relationships (including marriage)? Consult **1 Peter 1:3–5; Matthew 22:30**.
