One Flesh: The Richness of a God-Honoring Marriage
Passage: Selected Scriptures

1. Read **Genesis 2:24; Proverbs 12:4a; 18:22; 19:14**. What do these texts reveal about the intrinsic goodness of marriage? How do these passages motivate you to live out your calling (as a husband or a wife) more faithfully?
2. Read **Psalms 139:23–24**. If you were to pray this Psalm in reflection upon your role in your marriage, what sins or stagnancy (on your part) might God reveal? Why is it important for each spouse to go through this exercise individually, rather than simply insisting that the other do so? Consult **Luke 6:42**.
3. Read **Romans 13:8–10; Colossians 3:14; 1 John 4:19**. What is the essential ingredient of a truly God-honoring marriage? Consult **Ephesians 5:22–33**. In what ways are you demonstrating sacrificial, Christlike love toward your spouse? In what ways can you grow?
4. Read **John 15:5; Colossians 3:4; 2 Peter 3:18**. If you are unmarried, in what ways do these passages of Scripture encourage you in your present-day walk with the Lord?
