The Gospel of Luke: Beholding His Glory

Passage: Luke 9:28–36

1. Read **Luke 9:28–29**. At Jesus' transfiguration, Peter, James and John would have immediately thought of Moses and his experience on Mt. Sinai. Consult **Exodus 34:29–35**. What was actually being revealed in this moment? Consult **Revelation 1:9–18**; **Daniel 7:9**; **Colossians 1:19**; **2:9**. Where else in Scripture is the deity of Christ affirmed?

2. Read **Luke 9:30–32**. What does it mean that those who were with Jesus "saw His glory" (v. 32)? What does the Bible's testimony about the glory of Christ reveal about who He is? Consult **John 1:14**; **2 Corinthians 4:6**; **Hebrews 1:1–4**. How do these truths about divine glory spur you on to glorify the Lord with your life?

3. Read **Luke 9:33–36**. Peter, who in the moment offered to build booths for Jesus, Moses, and Elijah (v. 33), and who initially "kept silent, and reported to no one" what he saw (v. 36), would later report on what he witnessed at Jesus' transfiguration. Consult **2 Peter 1:16–18**. What does Peter's statement in **2 Peter 1:19** tell you about the supremacy of God's written Word and the confidence you can have in it?
