Guidelines for On-Site Services Beginning May 24:

We will meet on-site for the May 24 Sunday Morning Worship Service at 10:00 am. Due to restrictions regarding on-site services some members of our congregation will not be able to attend services immediately so we will continue to provide multiple ways to access our services online.

There are several restrictions and guidelines regarding on-site services from the Nebraska Department of Health and Human Services that we need to be aware of. These include the following:

- Those who are sick or at risk are encouraged to stay home. This includes:
 - The elderly
 - People with underlying medical conditions
 - People who live with the elderly or those at risk
 - People with any illness
- Child-care is not permitted at this time. Since children under the age of Junior High are not used to sitting through the worship service we request that only Junior High age and older attend until the child-care restriction is lifted.
- Seating must be arranged to maintain social distancing (six feet) between parties. A “party” is defined as members of a household who live together. Due to this restriction the auditorium seats will be marked off by tape to indicate where families can sit.
- The six-foot distancing guideline between family groups should be observed before and after services. To assist with this requirement the congregation will be dismissed by row after the service starting from the back of the auditorium.
- Passing of the offering bags is not permitted; therefore, we will not take an offering. Offerings can be dropped off in the comment boxes at each exit.
- We will have volunteers holding doors so that those attending the service don't have to touch the doors. To better facilitate this, we will only be using three entrances – the southwest entrance, the southeast (small canopy) entrance, and the northeast (large canopy) entrance.
